Construction notes

Double check angle cuts before making them, some adjustments may have to be made.

Min Wax polyshades used, old maple #330/430. If using this product be careful not to apply a heavy coat,

you get runs of color easily on vertical surfaces.

Once you get the desired shade, top coat with gloss poly.

Do not fasten the bottom plywood sheet in the desk till top has been screwed on.

Use 3/4 square strips to make a ledge for bottom to sit on.

I used home made 3/4" T&G pine boards for back but 5/16" x 3 1/2" cottage grade pine could be used instead. Purchased locally at lumber yard.
